2. **Talk about language barriers.** What do you call your bib material type or bib formats? What's missing from the list? Moved the list [here](#). There is a lot of variation in how our ILS's manage this information. Some have fixed fields in the bib records that indicate format. Others utilize MARC fields like the leader, 006,007, and 008 to indicate broad format and utilize subject and genre headings to help narrow. Several ILSs utilize fields in the item records to show format. The question was asked whether or not we wanted to examine public catalog formats as well, but that might be a later project.
