- 008 as complete as possible (Content type 6, audience and language code, fiction, nonfiction)
- Appropriate identifying number (020, 024, 022, 028) consider adding subfield q. (ex. |q(paperback))
- 040 (recommended)
- 1xx/7xx with \$e relationship designator
- 245 Volume numbers follow transcription field rules ***
- 246 Titles with numbers in them, alternate spellings, split words (When relevant)
- 246 Varying form of title could include part or volume number
- 250 Edition statement if appropriate
- 264 As complete as possible.
- 300 Last numbered page ***
- 3XX follow RDA
- 490/8xx when relevant
- 520
- 521 When known or found on resource
- Subject headings 6xx
 - Use of at least one controlled LC vocabulary term.
 - Additional subject headings as appropriate
 - Include for all audiences: |vComic books, strips, etc.
 - Include |vJuvenile fiction, |vJuvenile literature as appropriate
- At least one 655 LC genre heading (options abound!)
 - Common genre headings for graphic novels might include:
 - Comics (Graphic works)
 - Graphic novels
 - Manga

- Not all comics are graphic novels, but all graphic novels are comics.
